RV Site Improvements

ECCO has expanded its investment in safety, security and user improvements, including:

- Mast mounted high intensity lighting for improved night-time security and evening visibility;
- Additional interior fencing to separate the RV site from landfill operations: controlling the opportunity for casual landfill users to gain access to the RV site;

- Hiring full-time night watchmen to overview site security;
- Landscaping with tress, shrubs and grass cover on the landfill to reduce blowing dust and for aesthetic reasons;
- Placing and compacting additional gravel to reduce mud on the site and to improve stall conditions and access.

You will be aware that 24th Street in front of the site is now under

construction. We are advised 24th Street should be open for traffic by September. A new permanent access to serve the RV area exclusively has been built and will be available when 24th Street is reopened. In the meantime a new controlled access has been constructed at the north end of the RV site, to control access and use of the site. We will advise you when this is to be replaced by the new access.

RV Site Use

Much effort and expense has also been invested in marking and numbering stalls. All stalls have now been assigned, making it particularly important for renters to **ONLY** use their own stall. Please do not park in someone

else's stall, as it is confusing and a distinct nuisance! Please keep your stall number somewhere in your unit or mark the number on the side of your hitch, so when you return, you can re-enter your own rented stall.

Tip: When backing your RV into your stall your assigned stall number should be on the Passenger or right hand side of your vehicle or RV/ Trailer.
